

Father Sébastien NKOA, OP

Father Sébastien NKOA, OP, is a catholic priest, belonging to the congregation of the Dominican friars.

He was born in Cameroon and did his studies there up to the Master's degree in Finance. He worked for a couple of years as a bank manager at Société Général, a French bank in Cameroon. Feeling the call to the priesthood, he resigned from his position as a bank manager to join the Dominican seminary.

He was sent to Burundi, Rwanda, Ivory Coast, Kenya, Central African Republic, and France to complete his formation program for his priesthood. During those years of formation, Father Sébastien completed many other degrees and certificates, including an MBA in Sustainable Development, project management and financing, a certificate in International Financial Relationships, and a certificate in stock market management. He participated as a consultant to many United Nations programs and sessions on sustainable development.

He was ordained a priest in 2017 in Paris.

Back in his home country, he was respectively an assistant parish priest at Saint Thomas Aquinas University chaplaincy of Douala, then Superior of the Dominicans in Douala, and the founder parish priest of Saint Catherine of Sienna parish of Bonaberi in Douala/ Cameroon.

Presently, Father Sébastien is an assistant parish priest at Saint Anne parish at Efok in Obala in Cameroon. He continues with his passion as a finance person by lecturing on finance, and entrepreneurship, at the Catholic University of Milan, Saint Jean University in Cameroon. He is the project director of the diocese of Obala, CODASC/CARITAS member of the same diocese.

He will be defending his PhD thesis in June this year on organizational finance.
